



Stillwater National Wildlife Refuge Complex is composed of three refuges: Stillwater, Fallon, and Anaho Island. It encompasses a great diversity of habitat, from freshwater marshes and river habitat to brackish water marshes, alkali playas, extensive salt desert shrublands, a 25-mile long sand dune complex, and a small island in a desert lake.

During Spring months, thousands of waterfowl return to nest, including Redhead, Cinnamon teal, Gadwall, Avocet, Grebes, and Stilt. Songbirds also start to appear during these months, returning from their summer homes to breed here in Lahontan valley or further to the North.

Another buildup of birds occurs in the fall, August through November, as the thousands of birds make their return trip to their southern wintering grounds. The fall waterfowl migration peaks during October and November as 200,000 Pintail, Northern Shoveler, Green-winged teal, and nearly 25% of the Pacific Flyway population of Canvasback, can be found on the refuge.

Tundra swans are prominent winter residents, sometimes exceeding 8,000 in January. Other visitors from the North include Canada geese, Snow geese, Rough-legged hawks, and Bald eagles.

Waterflow for all of the refuge land is dependant upon snow fall in the Sierra-Nevada's, the Stillwater range, and some from the Humboldt range to the North. A dry winter in these mountains, means a dry summer in the refuges and fewer birds stay to breed. A lot of rain and snow in the mountains, means very wet conditions, and birds, everywhere!

This list contains over 250 birds which have been documented on Stillwater National Wildlife Refuge Complex, from those seen every season, to a group of birds that have been documented less than 5 times.
